EdQa 121-264 (XU1) L6 (25-30 cm) (Figure 16) This is a large quartzite cobble with a groove pecked around the middle. Both distal ends are battered. max. length 25.2 mm; max. width 30.5 mm; max. thickness 9.4 mm;
